

















Sex education will begin in Kindergarten with lessons on "gender identity"

Third graders will learn about how they can take "hormone blockers" to change from a boy to a girl, or vice versa


In sixth grade, students will be instructed on anal and oral sex, condom-wearing and the "pregnancy option" of abortion


Definition of "sex" causes confusion.....
